

## Metadata Standards Catalog

How can I find metadata standard established in my domain?

Where can I get information about metadata standards?

How can I propagate a metadata standard I am using?



Metadata is the backbone of sustainable research and consequently also for the Helmholtz Metadata Collaboration (HMC) Platform. There are hundreds of metadata standards available but starting off with applying a suitable standard is often hard as finding them is not that easy. On the other hand, if someone is using a promising metadata standard in a certain domain it's hard to spread the word throughout the community.

The **Metadata Standards Catalog (MSC)** is supposed to facilitate finding established metadata standards on the one hand and to promote used standards on the other hand. This makes the MSC a central information source on metadata standards for HMC.

Furthermore, the MSC can be seamlessly integrated into the HMC service ecosystem by connecting it to the **Metastore** supporting machine readability of registered standards as well as build-in validation of metadata document.
